Claude (Anthropic)

Best For: Complex ID tasks, analysis, long-form content, nuanced pedagogical decisions

Overview

Claude has emerged as a favorite among instructional designers (26% adoption) for tasks requiring nuance, analysis, and adherence to complex instructions. Excels at understanding ID principles and creating pedagogically sound content.

Key Capabilities

- **Large Context:** Process entire manuals or multiple documents at once
- **Analysis Excellence:** Outstanding for needs analysis and evaluation
- **ID Knowledge:** Understands Bloom's taxonomy, ADDIE, SAM
- **Long-Form Content:** Creates comprehensive guides and scenarios
- **Accuracy:** Less prone to hallucinations than alternatives
- **Document Creation:** Can create Word docs, spreadsheets directly

ChatGPT (OpenAI)

Best For: General content creation, quick drafts, brainstorming, versatile everyday use

Overview

ChatGPT is the most widely adopted AI tool among IDs: 84% have tried it and 57% use it daily. Its versatility, ease of use, and continuous improvements make it a go-to tool for a wide range of ID tasks.

Key Capabilities

- **Versatile Creation:** Handles objectives to scenarios to job aids
- **Image Generation:** DALL-E integration creates images directly
- **Web Browsing:** Can search for current information
- **Document Analysis:** Upload and analyze PDFs, docs, spreadsheets
- **Code Generation:** Create HTML, JavaScript for interactions
- **Custom GPTs:** Create specialized AI assistants for ID tasks

Microsoft Copilot & Synthesia

Best For: Enterprise environments, Microsoft 365 integration, documentation

- **M365 Integration:** Works in Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Teams
- **Enterprise Security:** Built-in compliance and data protection
- **Data Analysis:** Excellent for Excel analysis of survey data
- **Pricing:** \$20/month consumer; \$30/user/month enterprise + M365 base

Synthesia

Best For: AI avatar videos, multilingual video content, rapid video production

Adoption: 59% of IDs have used it; 29% call it their favorite tool

- **AI Avatars:** 230+ diverse professional presenters
- **Time Savings:** 50-60% reduction in video production time
- **Languages:** Create videos in 140+ languages
- **Rating:** ★★★★★ for video production and multilingual content

ROI Considerations

- **Articulate AI:** Save 20 hrs/month at \$75/hr = \$1,500 value for \$108/month cost
- **ChatGPT Plus:** Save 5 hrs/month at \$75/hr = \$375 value for \$20/month cost
- **Synthesia:** Save 10 hrs/month on video at \$75/hr = \$750 value for \$67/month

Most IDs achieve 10-15x ROI on AI tool investments.

Recommended Tool Combinations

Essential Stack (Budget)

\$20/month

- ChatGPT - primary content, images, research

Best for: Freelancers, small teams, getting started with AI

Professional Stack

\$1,989/year per user

- Articulate 360 with AI (\$1,749/year) - course authoring
- Claude Pro (\$20/month) - analysis, research

Best for: Individual IDs or small teams focused on course development

Video-Heavy Stack

\$2,757/year per user

- Claude Pro (\$20/month) – analysis, research
- Articulate 360 (\$1,749 year) - course authoring
- Synthesia Creator (\$768/year) - video production

Best for: Organizations with significant training needs

Enterprise Stack

\$2,349/year per user

- Articulate 360 (\$1,749/year)
- Microsoft 365 Copilot (\$360/year) - docs, communication
- Claude Pro (\$240/year) – analysis, research

Best for: Large organizations with M365, need for security

Conclusion: Building Your AI Stack

Key Selection Criteria

1. **Primary authoring tool** - If Articulate, AI Assistant is essential
2. **Content type mix** - Video-heavy = add Synthesia
3. **Enterprise needs** - Security, compliance, integration
4. **Budget** - Start small, add tools as ROI proves itself

Final Recommendations

- **Start with one tool** (Claude Pro) to build skills
- **Add Articulate AI** if you use A360 - ROI is immediate
- **Consider Synthesia** if video is >20% of content
- **Evaluate quarterly** - AI tools evolve rapidly
- **Track ROI** - Document time savings to justify investments
